The quarter-cent sales tax will generate \$50 million a year for increased teacher supplements and additional classroom support. It will also provide funding for arts and culture organizations to partner with Charlotte-Mecklenburg schools to restore school field trips.

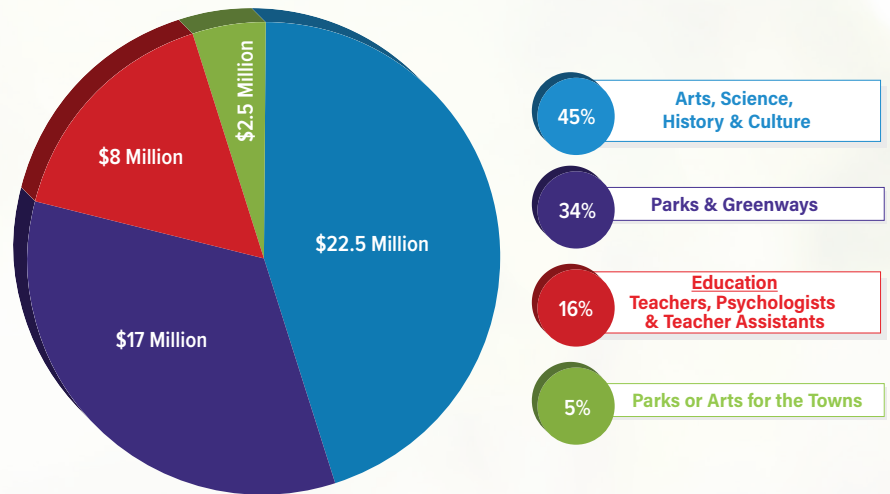
The proposed \$17 million a year in increased funding for our parks and greenways will revitalize our system, which was ranked near the bottom of a recent national study of metropolitan parks systems. Citizens have demanded an increased focus on our parks and greenways, and a vote FOR the referendum on November's ballot will make that a reality.

The new funds will be used to eliminate barriers to participation – expanding arts and cultural programs into neighborhoods across the county, regardless of where residents live or what they can afford.

This new revenue will be transformational for Mecklenburg County families. The enhancement of our quality of life and community enrichment throughout the county is well worth this investment.

Renewed focus on our parks and greenways; increased access to arts, science and history programs; and investment in our public-school system will make Mecklenburg County an even better place to live.
